Defunding is a Misnomer

What defunding really entails is preventing Planned Parenthood - a key safety-net provider - from receiving reimbursements for providing preventative health care services to Medicaid patients, just as any other health care provider would.

Federal Cuts Would Impact Local Taxpayers

- For every 1,000 women who lose access to publicly-funded family planning, 288 new unintended pregnancies result.
- Unintended pregnancies put women at greater risk for homelessness, family hunger, poor birth outcomes, and long-term dependence on publicly-funded programs.
- For every \$1 invested in family planning services, the state saves at least \$7 on unintended pregnancy costs and long-term social service costs. (Guttmacher Institute, December 2014)
